The following precautions should be kept in mind while forming opposites.

1. The 'parts of speech' of the word should be retained, that is, the opposite of a noun should also be a noun, and the opposite of a verb should also be a verb. As:

2. The opposite of 'verb' will be 'verb'. In addition, tense of the word shall have similar tense of opposite word. As
